Biographical/Historical note

Sophie Blackall is an author and illustrator who predominantly illustrates children's books. On her home page, Blackall lists a variety of sources from which she draws illustration inspiration: "Japanese woodblocks. Chinese packaging design. Old photographs. Maps. Scientific diagrams. Jellyfish. Moby Dick. Iridescent feathers. Train journeys. Figs. Postage stamps," and other things.

Blackall's work has won many of awards, including: The Ezra Jack Keats Award for *Ruby's Wish*; Founder's Award, Society of Illustrators, and Bulletin of the Center for Children's Books Blue Ribbon Award, both for *Wild Boars*; Top Ten Picture Books citation, New York Times, 2010, for *Big Red Lollipop*; honor book citation, Horn Book, 2011, for *Pecan Pie Baby*; Randolph Caldecott Medal, 2016, for *Finding Winnie: The True Story of the World's Most Famous Bear*.
