Biographical/Historical note

Frank Murphy is a teacher for Council Rock School District in Holland, PA and a successful children's book author of historical fiction/biography books for young readers. Many of Murphy's books have been produced under Random House's "Step into Reading" History Readers series. In 2001, he published *Ben Franklin and the Magic Squares*, a book that explored Franklin's fascination with the recreational mathematics activity known as a "Magic Square."

In 2006, Murphy's book *Babe Ruth Saves Baseball* received the Oppenheim Toy Portfolio Gold Award; the book was included in the Intermediate Section of the "Easy-to-Read Books" booklist in the 2006 publication of Oppenheim Toy Portfolio's *The Best Toys, Books, DVDs & Music for Kids*.
