Over the summer, students can lose two-three months of reading skills gained in school, making it harder to become strong readers by 4th grade. You can help by integrating literacy activities into your daily program.

The Read and Rise Site Package

- Read-aloud kits (multiple titles, each with lesson plans and activity ideas)
- Independent reading collection
- Literacy games
- Staff training and help with integrating activities
- Onsite support from a Literacy Coach
- Recognition for your participation

Program Requirements

- Minimum requirement of literacy activities: one hour for rising 1st-4th graders, four days per week for four weeks
- Literacy activities include: read-alouds, independent reading, writing in journals, Readers Theater, Scrabble SLAM and Sight Word BINGO
- One half-day staff training

Program Fees

- \$350 to offset program costs valued at over \$1,750
- \$250 early bird rate until March 23
